Supporting courses in comparative literature

Choose any TWO additional CMLIT courses. 6

Foreign language

Choose TWO foreign language courses beyond the 003 level. Double 6 credits

Additional courses

Choose FOUR literature courses in the department of your foreign language major. Double 12 credits
(These must be *literature* courses.)

If you have a major in another language with a literature focus, you may add a CMLIT major with 18 credits.

Choose TWO foreign language courses beyond the 003 level. 6

Supporting courses in comparative literature

Choose any TWO additional CMLIT courses. 6

Additional courses

Choose FOUR courses in English. Double 12 credits
(These must be *literature* courses
and not creative writing and rhetoric courses.)

If you have a major in English, you may add a CMLIT major with 24 credits.
